RATING REQUIREMENTS OF LHSAA FOOTBALL OFFICIALS

Updated 6/14/11

To become REGISTED, an official must:

- 1. Be registered with the LHSAA and a local officials' association.
- 2. Attend the state rules clinic
- 3. Make 70% or above on the LHSAA test to work varsity games.
- 4. Work at least 10 freshman or junior varsity contest before working varsity.
- 5. Be a high school graduate or be twenty-one years of age.
- 6. Shall not work past the first week of playoffs in any sport
- <u>NOTE</u>: Officials will not receive a card until he/she has met all the criteria listed above. ***ANY OFFICIAL FAILING TO TAKE THE TEST OR ATTEND THE CLINIC MUST RETURN AS A <u>REGISTERED</u> OFFICIAL THE NEXT YEAR OF REGISTRATION WITH HIS/HER LOCAL ASSOCIATION.***

To become CERTIFIED, an official must:

- 1. Registered with the LHSAA and a local officials' association a minimum of four (4) years.
- 2. Attend the state rules clinic
- 3. Make 86% or above on the LHSAA test to work varsity games.
- 4. Attend 70 % of the local association meetings
- 5. Work at least 5 varsity contest the prior season.
- 6. Attend a LHSOA sponsored camp or an approved continuing education workshop once every two years.
- <u>NOTE</u>: Any transfer official with 5 years or more experience must serve 1 year as a registered official before he/she is eligible to become certified.
- <u>NOTE</u>: Assignment secretaries will always consider an individual's rating, past preference, experience of an official, and importance of the game to be worked when assigning officials. Officials failing to pass the online test may work as clock operators in varsity games and on the field, in junior varsity and junior high games.
- <u>NOTE</u>: ***Your registration with the LHSAA does not guarantee you any game assignments at any of level of play***



8.8.5 Football Officials' Fee as adopted by the LHSAA in all classes:

1. REGULAR SEASON Certified Rated Officials Registered Rated Official Clock Operator

\$90.00 per official, per game\$65.00 per official, per game\$45.00 per official. Per game

2. PLAYOFF GAMES Certified Rated Officials Registered Rated Official Clock Operator

\$105.00 per official, per game\$75.00 per official, per game\$55.00 per official. Per game

- 3. As adopted in all games, the crew referee's fee shall be increased by \$15.00
- 4. Officials working games in the Superdome Classis shall be paid \$115.00 per game and clock operators shall be paid \$75.00 per game, plus travel pay.
